ORDINANCE NO. 2097

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A VARIANCE TO ALLOW A COMMERCIAL BUILDING AND DUPLEXES IN AN R-2 RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT IN THE CITY OF MT. CARMEL, WABASH COUNTY, ILLINOIS
