

ORDINANCE NO. 2084

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4, ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARTICLE I SEC. 4-9

WHEREAS, in order for the city ordinances regulating the sale of alcoholic beverages to recognize the additional licensed premises where alcoholic liquor is sold the City Council of the City of Mount Carmel, Wabash County, Illinois, has determined that it is necessary to amend Chapter 4 Alcoholic Beverages, Article I, Sec. 4-9

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. CARMEL, WABASH COUNTY, ILLINOIS, Chapter 4 Alcoholic Beverages, Article I, Sec. 4-9 is hereby amended to state as follows

Sec. 4-9. – Certain persons prohibited in licensed premises

> (a) No person to whom the sale, gift or delivery of any alcoholic liquor is prohibited because of age, either alone or accompanied by an adult, shall enter or be suffered to remain in or on the portion of the licensed premises where alcoholic liquor is sold under either a Class A, Class B, Class C or Class H license or any room or place adjoining the same where alcoholic liquors are sold or served or suffered to be consumed; provided, however, that this section shall not apply to any licensed premises where the principal business consists of the sale of food and/or other commodities, including a bowling establishment, and services rendered in connection therewith.

Except as herein amended, all other terms, and conditions of Sec. 4-9 shall remain unchanged.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
